- 95% of students attaining a Duke of Edinburgh Bridge Program Award in Years 7 and 8.
- 75% of students achieving a Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award at the completion of Year 10.
- 5% NAPLAN Upper Three Bands relative gain improvement in Years 7 and 9. Headline Indicators for U2B% change from red to orange.

## Our initiatives include

- Promotion of “The Runcorn Way”; High Expectations and Personalised Learning within the school and wider community.
- Knowing each student and how they learn through personalised learning plans.
- Providing professional development and coaching to school leaders and teachers in the areas of; pedagogy, coaching and mentoring, reading and classroom management.
- Providing professional guidance to school leaders and teachers through two Literacy Coaches; Reading to Learn, Literacy across the Curriculum.
- Providing engagement development programs and positive attendance incentives for students.
- Providing a developmental welfare and camp program aligned to the Duke of Edinburgh programs.

Widely marketing “The Runcorn Way” and enacting High Expectations and Personalised Learning. (\$50,000)

Implementing Personalised Learning Plans and monitoring the learning journey of students from Years 7-12, and intervening where appropriate. (\$10,000.00)

Implementing a whole school professional development plan. (\$87,000.00)

Employing two Literacy Coaches and additional intervention and engagement staff. (\$250,000.00)

Collaborating with our community partners to develop and implement the Duke of Edinburgh programs. (\$20,505.00)
