Meet the following targets:

- 95% of students receiving an A-C in all subject areas from Years 7-12.
- 5% NAPLAN Upper 3 Bands relative gain improvement in Years 7 and 9. Headline indicators for U2B% change from red to green in reading and numeracy.
- Track student writing samples during coaching cycles across all faculties as short term improvement measures.
- Track implementation of the Runcorn SHS Curriculum and Assessment Framework planning and assessment cycles. Maintain moderation records for medium term improvement comparison measures.
- 100% of Individual Curriculum Plans developed, implemented and reported to parents.

Our initiatives include


- Promotion of "The Runcorn Way; High Expectations and Personalised Learning."
- Developing school leader and teacher knowledge and understanding of the Year 7-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.
- Developing school leader and teacher knowledge and understanding of the Year 11 and 12 Senior Assessment and Tertiary Entrance curriculum and assessment framework.
- Developing our school leaders' and teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle.
- Developing school leader and teacher knowledge and understanding of differentiation and inclusive teaching practices in the 7-10 Australian Curriculum.
- Building teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to determine the different year-level curriculum some students require and to develop and successfully implement Individual Curriculum Plans.
- Continuing to provide professional development and coaching to school leaders and teachers in the areas of; pedagogy, reading, writing and classroom management.
- Building our collaborative partnerships with our Reading to Learn cluster schools and Statewide Inquiry Into Writing partner schools.
- Continue to develop the socio-emotional well-being program for students (including Duke of Edinburgh).


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Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Widely marketing "The Runcorn Way" and enacting High Expectations and Personalised Learning. (\$20,000)
- Employing a Band 7 Deputy Principal Inclusion and a Head of Department to lead inclusive practices and differentiation across the school. (\$225,000)
- Employing a Literacy Coach, and additional intervention and engagement staff. (\$130,000)
- Implementing a whole school Australian Curriculum and Senior Assessment and Tertiary Entrance professional development plan. (\$30,000)
- Continue to support student access to complete Duke of Edinburgh Bridge, Bronze and Silver Awards (\$3 000)
