Under this agreement for 2022 Runcorn State High School will receive



This funding will be used to

- Build a strong learning culture of engagement that leads to improved achievement for all students.
 - 75% students with tertiary education pathways and 10%+ students with an ATAR of 90 or more
 - $\circ~~55\%$ or more of students receive A or B across all subjects.
 - 91% attendance or better as a pre-requisite to represent the school in student leadership, competitions or other special events.
 - BYOx usage rates show 40%+ usage per day
 - Implement an approach to Positive Education by introducing Wellbeing Lessons to all year levels.
- Continue to develop staff capacity in using evidence-based, instructional approaches that build students curiosity, self-efficacy, wellbeing and ability to learn independently
 - All staff have an annual performance development goal aligned to Runcorn High Impact Teaching Strategies and all are engaging students in "Runcorn Reading Routines" each week.
 - o 80% of students receive Excellent or Very Good ratings on report cards for Semester 2 for 'Effort.'
- Students and Staff are supported to maintain and improve their resilience, persistence, emotional intelligence and positive relationships
 - Improvement of baseline results from Mi7 Student Wellbeing Survey (2021/2022) and identifying successes and areas for further development within our approach to Positive Education for 2023.

Our initiatives include

- Continue to develop sub-school Personalised Learning approaches (Junior, Transition, Senior)
- Sustained focus on literacy (Runcorn Reading Routines) and pedagogy (Gradual Release of Responsibility) models to ensure consistent best practice approaches for all students.
- Continued implementation of a distinct wellbeing approach (PERMAH Seligman) for staff and students
- Staff development in eLearning and associated resources to support increased BYODx uptake.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Retain current teaching ratio and leadership density to support sub-school system (eg OWLs, Coordinators, etc) (\$410 000)
- Staff professional development and collaborative planning (\$90 000)
- Investment in Positive Education Curriculum Activities (\$20 525)
